### **Decorating the Cross**

Bring your beautiful flowers and fresh cuttings to flower the Easter cross. Symbolic of Jesus' resurrection and the gift of new life in him, the flowered cross is brought forward during the opening hymn at each service. After services, the cross will stand on the front portico, bearing witness to Christ's resurrection to all who pass by.
